The course is appropriate for anyone 21 or over with at least Level 2 in youth work, childcare or teaching or at least 2 years' experience working with children. You will need to hold a current Garda Vetting and to hold or acquire a16 hour outdoor paediatric first aid certificate.

The training runs over 8 days and includes and at least 110 hours of self-study over approximately 9 months. In this time you will...

- plan and deliver a six week Forest School programme with a group of children that includes practical activities based on reflective assessment
- complete a practical workbook supporting the delivery and development of Forest School
- create other materials demonstrating your understanding of both learning theory and woodland environments
